The Alachua Stone Age Fair will be an educational show, modeled after the Loveland Stone Age Fair that has been held for the past 73 years. This show will feature private and public artifact and fossil collections but will not allow any commercial buying or selling of prehistoric artifacts or fossils. A number of highly regarded speakers will be presenting the latest information on Paleolithic people and animals in North America, concurrently with the displays in the exhibition hall. Modern flintknappers will display their skills, booksellers will be present, and refreshments will be available.
